

Transport Code of Conduct

Students using the van services must comply with the following code of conduct:

- I will sit in my seat for the whole journey
- I will not eat on the van
- I will not throw anything inside or out of the van
- I will always respect other students and their property
- I will not use any physical or verbal behaviour that may distract the van driver
- I will talk respectfully with the driver and other students
- I will not talk too loudly or yell
- I will not behave in a way that could put the driver or other students at risk
- I will always obey the instructions of the van driver and the teachers responsible
- I understand that if I cause damage in any way my parent/caregiver will be billed for the cost of repairs

Parents and caregivers agree to:

- be there to walk the child to the bus every morning and be present when the child returns home daily
- ensure children are ready and waiting out the front of the property for the van to arrive
- acknowledge the requirement of advising the driver if children aren't needing to be collected

If the code of conduct or non-payment of bus fess should occur, the privilege of using school transport could be suspended or withdrawn immediately. Caregivers will then be required to find alternative transport to get the student to and from school.
